



# Cyberbullying

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Grades K-2



## Introduction

Cyberbullying has become a problem with many young children. While there is no law against it, 49 states do have anti-bullying legislation. Students will identify what a cyberbully is and describe strategies on how to deal with such a situation. They will explore this topic by watching a video, then answering a writing prompt on the topic of cyberbullying.

## Learning Objectives

## Materials Needed

## Procedure

1. Have students watch a short video about what bullying and cyberbullying is, as well as the strategies students should take when and if they are in that situation.
2. Then, have students answer the writing prompt, "If you are cyberbullied, what steps should you take?" Instruct students to write a short essay (younger students can draw a picture) about the steps they would take if they are ever cyberbullied. Be sure to encourage students to write details.

## Evaluation

Students will be assessed on how well they followed the guidelines for the writing prompt.
